Students choose or make sentences for their partner to draw on the board or some shared A3 paper, with sensible combinations and strange combinations both okay.

Christmas actions Present Continuous pick and draw competition

Students choose or make sentences for everyone to draw, with points for the best picture.

Christmas actions Present Continuous guessing game

Students secretly choose or make a sentence, and draw until someone guesses what the sentence is. They can draw more, circle important parts, etc, but not speak or write words.

Whole sentence cards

He is eating chocolate coins/ A boy is opening and eating chocolate coins.
Santa's sleigh is flying./ A sled is flying across the sky.
The king is giving a speech on television/ The king is speaking on TV.

A wreath is hanging on the door/ A holly wreath is decorating the door.
They are kissing under the mistletoe/ The boy and girl are kissing.
They are looking at the sunrise/ They are watching the sun come up.
A girl is opening a present/ She is unwrapping a teddy bear.
He is opening an advent calendar/ A boy is opening the door on an advent calendar.
He is peeling a potato/ A man is taking the skin off potatoes.
She is pouring gravy/ A woman is putting sauce on the Xmas dinner.
They are pulling a Xmas cracker/ A boy and girl are making a Xmas cracker go bang.
Santa is putting a present in a stocking/ He is filling a stocking.
She is putting a coin into the Xmas pudding/ A woman is hiding a coin in the pudding.
A star is shining/ A bright star is lighting up the sky.
Baby Jesus is sleeping next to a sheep/ He is sleeping near a sheep.
Santa is standing on the roof/ He is standing on the house.
An angel is standing on the Xmas tree/ A fairy is standing on top of the tree.
Santa is wearing a hat/ He is wearing a red and white hat.
