

Do You Want Questions Coin Game with dates, weather and feelings vocabulary

Choose one of the times below, secretly flip a coin, and try to get this answer from your partner by asking a "Do you want...?" question:

Heads = Yes, I do.

Tails = No, I don't.

After they answer (honestly), show them which side of the coin was up. You get one point if they gave the answer that you wanted, for example one point if you said "It's April. Do you want to swim in the sea?", they said "No, I don't" and tails is the top side of the coin when you flipped it and when you show it to your partner.
