

Is there/ Are there and prepositions dice game

Draw an empty house each. Ask your partner a yes/ no question about what is in your house using the table below like "Are there two sofas in your bathroom?" or "Is there a table in front of your television?" Your partner will roll a dice and then answer with the reply below matching that number below, e.g. "Yes, there are" if the number is 1, or "No, there isn't. There is a table next to the television" if the number is 6. Take turns doing the same until you have ten things in each house or until your teacher stops you.

Answers for each number on the dice

1. Yes, there...
2. No, there... There... (*change the number, but keep the thing and place the same, for example “No, there aren’t. There are three”*)
3. Yes, there...
4. No, there... There... (*change the thing, but keep the number and place the same, for example “No, there isn’t. There is a chair”*)
5. Yes, there...
6. No, there... There... (*change the place, but keep the number and thing the same, for example “No, there aren’t. There are two pizzas in the bathroom”*)

Ask about anything above you don’t understand, couldn’t make a question out of, etc, working together to make suitable questions each time.

Maybe after changing groups, test each other on your memories of what is in your houses with questions and answers like those above.
