

Phrasal Verbs Dice Game

Phrasal verbs example sentences dice game

Use the table below that your teacher tells you do (or choose one yourself if your teacher tells you to do that). Roll the dice twice and try to make an example sentence using that phrasal verb. You get one point if your partner accepts the sentence as making sense and the sentence is different from any other sentences people have made during the game. If it doesn't make sense, if it is the same as previous sentences or if you give up, you get no marks. Play then passes to the next person. Note that some of the combinations are not possible.

Phrasal verbs storytelling dice game

Tell a story line by line, rolling the dice each time. You get one point for each line you can come up with which uses the phrasal verb and continues the story. If you can't use the phrasal verb, you can continue the story any way you like, but you don't get a point. Note that some of the combinations that could come up by using the dice don't make sense and/or can't be used to tell a story, so you may sometimes have to give up.

Version 1

5	hand	forward
6	hang	off

Version 2

Number	First throw	Second throw
1	hold	up
2	look	in
3	put	over
4	stand	back
5	stay	on
6	switch	away

Version 3

Number	First throw	Second throw
1	take	up
2	throw	in
3	turn	over
4	roll	back
5	run	on
6	sleep	away
