

## Verbs and adverbs of frequency dice games

### Game 1 – Make me say yes or no

Secretly roll a dice, hiding it under your other hand, then ask your partner a Yes/ No question to try to get the answer next to that number below. For example, if you roll a 4, you can ask “Do you have seventeen brothers?” to get the answer “No, I don’t”.

1. Make me say “Yes”
2. Make me say “Yes”
3. Make me say “Yes”
4. Make me say “No”
5. Make me say “No”
6. Make me say “No”

### Game 2 – Make me say yes or no with this verb 1

Secretly roll a twice dice, hiding it under your other hand each time. The first roll decides which answer above you should get, and the second roll decides which verb below you must use in your question. For example, if you roll a 1 and then a 4, you can ask “Do you often wear shorts?” or “Do you like wearing sandals?” to try to get a “Yes, I do” answer.

1. sit
2. ride
3. eat
4. wear
5. read
6. play

### Game 3 – Make me say yes or no with this verb 2

Secretly roll a twice dice, hiding it under your other hand each time. The first roll decides which answer above you should get, and the second roll decides which verb below to use in your question. For example, if you roll a 3 and then a 6, you can ask “Do you sometimes make cookies?” or “Do you like making mud pies?” to try to get a “Yes, I do” answer.

1. study
2. go
3. have
4. talk
5. watch
6. make

### Game 4 – Adverbs of frequency answer me

Secretly roll a dice, hiding it under your other hand, then ask a Yes/ No question to try to get the answer next to that number below.

1. No, never
2. Yes, sometimes
3. Yes, often
4. Yes, usually
5. Yes, always
6. Yes,... (FREE CHOICE)
